12) Reservoir Creek Golf:



13) Ontario County Park:

14) Skippy Raines Disk Golf Course:

15) **View Wind Turbines Up-close:** Just 4 miles outside of the Village you can view these ominous, towering wind turbines. The panoramic view of the hills is also beautiful. Take Rt. 21 South 2.8 miles and turn left on County Line Road. In 200 ft., turn right on Lyons Rd. (a dirt road) and ascend to the top of the hill. Voila! Note that all of the property on either side of the road is private so just pull over and enjoy the sights and sounds, but please be respectful of the private property. The road to the base of the turbines, as well as the farm fields, are private property.
