



Welcome to 60th Annual Naples Creek Rainbow Trout Derby!

All fish entered in the tournament will be photographed, measured, and recorded with the FishDonkey app. (<https://www.fishdonkey.com/#get-the-app>), hopefully just this year. For those anglers who use a smartphone and simply do not use Social Media: Here is how to sign up: 1. Download the FishDonkey app. 2. Join "Naples Creek" 3. PRIZES Categories and leaderboards will update throughout the contest so check the leaderboards through your app to follow the tournament progress.

The standard award categories are:

- Grand prize trophy for largest rainbow trout, Sponsored by Mitchell Joseph Insurance
- Trophy for longest rainbow trout caught by a male angler.
- Trophy for longest rainbow trout caught by a female angler.
- Trophy for longest rainbow trout caught by a boy angler 16 & under.
- Trophy for longest rainbow trout caught by a girl angler 16 & under.
- Trophy for longest rainbow trout caught by an angler 65 & over.
- Jim Grove Memorial Trophy Award is for longest rainbow trout caught by a male angler with a Naples mailing address.
- Merton Woodard Memorial Trophy Award is for longest rainbow trout caught by a female angler with a Naples mailing address.
- Robert Linehan youth participation trophy is given to all registered youth participants 16 and under that caught a fish.

Prizes will be given to the top positions of each leaderboard category with the number of winning entries to be determined. Awards are presented based on length as determined through the mobile app and verified by tournament judges. The categories, species, and official rules can be found in the FishDonkey app. **Trophies will be handed out after 6pm on Sunday 4/4/21 at the Naples Fire Hall.** Please only come to the fire hall to get a trophy due to Covid.

RULES

FishDonkey App

All registration and payment must be completed using the app. The FishDonkey App will be used to photo document fish and will generate live leaderboards. The leaderboards will update throughout the event as fish are submitted. All entries will be considered unofficial until verified.

Measuring & Photo Documenting

All photos must be taken through the FishDonkey app and measurements can be done on a measuring board, measuring tape, or ruler. Only rainbow trout are eligible to be entered in the derby. Fish should be recorded immediately, and measurements noted by length. All submissions must include at least two photographs: 1) A pic of you holding the fish 2) A pic of the fish being measured. All participants must have their fish submitted before the end of the tournament. Practice the FishDonkey App ahead of time.
